- 1. These events will be run on track frequency 464.5500
- 2. Spotters can spot where they feel comfortable, there will be no active spotter stand.
- 3. The Drivers meeting will be held with all the weekly divisions, by the lineup board.
- 4. Pre race tech will be held at the track tech shed. All cars are required to report to tech.
- 5. Line ups will be completed via draw during pre race tech.
- 6. The races will be run on used MPST Hoosier 1070's
- 7. Tires must remain in impound at Scotia Speedworld at all times except race day.
- 8. Tires. Scotia Speedworld has only a small supply and can supply tires to a team(s) if necessary. If you have a relationship with a MPST team and can obtain used tires from them, please do so. Keep in mind these tires MUST come from the MPST impound ONLY.
- 9. Tires must be a race set, not a purchased practice set.
- 10. Tires chosen by teams must be full feature (80% laps) used and can be verified by MPST officials.
- 11. Line ups to be completed via pill draw.
